Playcentre fights to protect native tree



Children at Beachlands Maraetai Playcentre enjoy playing in and around this Pōhutukawa tree, which is under threat from the national Playcentre body who believe it should be cut down.

Beachlands Maraetai Play Centre (BMPC) parents have been left astounded by a directive to cut down a large Pōhutukawa tree on their grounds, in the name of health and safety.

The tree has provided shade and a natural climbing frame for children at the centre for decades without incident. But at a recent health and safety review undertaken by Playcentre Aotearoa, which oversees all playcentres in the country, the tree was deemed a risk.

BMPC has argued to save the tree, to be told that another solution could be to remove any branches lower than 2 metres

in height from the ground. In the case of this particular tree, most of the branches stem from a trunk base which is less than a metre in height, suggesting that all branches will need to be removed.

BMPC parent Olivia Herring says they were aware they might need to change a few things in their playground to make it health and safety compliant, but news that the tree must go was a shock.

Planning for future growth in Clevedon - an important request for community feedback

the sky over Clevedon Village recently was a reminder that ours is a growing community. With Clevedon Village expected to grow to more than 4000 residents in the coming years, the past month has seen community engagement in consultation on what some of our cherished public spaces might look like in the future – and how they might serve the people of the Wairoa Valley.

The first set of plans covers changes to Clevedon's treasured civic spaces; the community hall and adjacent carpark, library and playground, the Clevedon Village Reserve and the Clevedon Village District Centre. Located as they are at a busy intersection, between our two village churches, school and the main street businesses, these sites collectively form an important civic anchor in Clevedon community life. The concept plans under consultation are the result of a masterplanning process overseen by Franklin Local Board who engaged a design agency, Isthmus, to look at these important civic spaces to determine how they should respond to the incoming tide of growth.

The second set of plans under consultation are for Clevedon's A&P Showgrounds, an extraordinary local

The appearance of a tower crane in resource utilised by sports and equestrian clubs and for informal recreation. The concept plans for the showgrounds were also drafted by Isthmus.

It's important to remember the plans are just ideas for now, and budget has not been allocated to any of the significant works detailed in them (with the exception of an upgrade to an existing playground on North Road). However, as Council set their goals and priorities over the coming years, a collective vision for our growing village will be a cornerstone of the decision-making process around where to focus expenditure.

Creating a collective vision requires an informed and engaged community. It's clear from online chatter that, broadly speaking, the community is aware of the plans and interested in how our village will look in the future – and there's some great questions being asked. While some may feel a degree of scepticism about engaging in the consultation process, the Clevedon CBA encourages everyone who has feedback to direct this through the official channels to ensure that all feedback is heard by Council. A key area of focus for the CCBA has been to encourage community engagement initially in the development of the concept plans, and now in the consultation process.

Franklin Local Board Wairoa representative and Board chair Angela Fulljames has watched the process with great interest and has been a clear voice calling for user groups, stakeholders, and the wider community to provide views on the draft plans so the Board can assess what might need to be changed or prioritised. The Franklin Local Board hosted a drop in session at the Clevedon Community Hall on Thursday 2 May where the community was able to ask Local Board members questions about the plans and consultation process. Members of the Clevedon CBA were also in attendance to meet members of the community and understand their perspectives on the plans. There was good constructive conversation and a genuine interest in how these spaces might look, and serve our community, in future.

The Clevedon CBA encourages everyone to take a look at the plans online and have their say by 8 May 2024 - visit akhaveyoursay.aucklandcouncil.



Council reviews dog walking rules in light of Whitford dog attack

A Whitford family have lost their beloved 13-year-old dog after she was attacked by a pack of dogs at the Porterfield Road Reserve in Whitford.

The attack is the latest in a string of incidents involving dog pack walking business Stimulated K9, based in Takanini.

Barbara Wright was walking her two small dogs, Hugo and Kippa, on the Whitford bridle trail on Monday 8 April when she encountered a woman walking a pack of large dogs which were roaming the trail off-leash. Four of the pack rushed to attack Hugo and Kippa. Two further dogs, who were on leashes, attempted to join the attack, pulling the dog walker to the ground.

"I'm only 5'2" and I was fighting these dogs trying to get them off my dogs. I couldn't get Kippa out - I feel she put herself there to protect me and Hugo," says Barbara.

Wounded and bleeding herself, Barbara ignored her own injuries and rushed her dogs to Franklin Vets where Kippa was diagnosed with crushed ribs, a punctured lung, punctured bowel and a ruptured cruciate ligament. A week later, Kippa was euthanised due to the severity of her injuries.

The incident has left Barbara with over \$11,000 in vet bills, and she says she is deeply traumatised by the event.

The woman walking the pack of dogs was an employee of Stimulated K9. Stimulated K9's owner has messaged Barbara to apologise for the attack, and recently posted a message on her business Facebook page to say she had covered the veterinary costs - something Barbara says is untrue.

"When Kippa was at Franklin Vets, Stimulated K9 had offered to cover the cost of treating any puncture wounds," says Barbara. When the extent of Kippa's injuries became clear however, Barbara says Stimulated K9 said they could not afford to cover the cost. The business has contributed about \$2,000 and has said they are trying to reach a "collective agreement" to help with further costs, which Barbara says possibly means the attacking dogs' owners are being asked to contribute.

Kippa's death comes on the heels of a number of near-misses involving locals

who say their animals have been lucky to escape injury after encountering the pack walking business.

About one year ago, Harriet Brownall was walking with her dog, two preschoolers and a baby in a pram when she met a man and woman walking about 20 dogs. "Almost all big dogs - collies, German shepherds, husky mixes etc,' says Harriet.

Harriet says many of the dogs were offleash. "They were entirely out of control, I had to run out onto the sand with the kids and had to let my dog loose."

Harriet's dog was chased by the pack, but managed to escape and find her way back to Harriet's car.

The PC Times has spoken to three other local residents who have had close calls with the dog pack.

One of them, who does not wish to be named, posted a message on the local Grapevine page warning people about the dog walker. She says she was inundated with messages from people who had experienced similar encounters with Stimulated K9, which is identifiable by the white Toyota van it uses to transport dogs.

"The feedback was that Animal Management were usless," says the resident, adding that a group of locals have since embarked on a mission to ensure others are kept safe on the trail.

They have contacted Worksafe, the SPCA and Stimulated K9's owner, and have met with Council's Animal Management team.

"We've tried all the channels we are meant to be trying, but had no joy trying to effect any change. Now we want to spread awareness so that others can keep safe," says the resident.

The group says it understands that other communities have experienced similar issues with Stimulated K9 and were not happy to have the business operating in their areas.

"The concern was that with stories filtering through no changes were witnessed in regards to pack numbers, although the owner has said repeatedly she is 'making changes'. The dogs' owners were probably unaware of the risk their dogs face," says the resident.

Auckland Council Animal Management team leader Angie Castro says that an

investigation is underway into the attack Any proposed changes will be open to which resulted in Kippa's death.

"While this investigation is ongoing we are unable to provide further details, other to confirm that two dogs were seized in relation to the attack, and have since been released to their owners under strict confinement conditions. We can also confirm the incident took place in an offleash area."

The Porterfield Road Reserve area, which includes the bridle trail, is listed on Auckland Council's website as an offleash area. However signage at the reserve car park does not indicate this and only suggests the area is for pedestrians and horse riders.

Auckland Council says that currently a dog walker has the same legal responsibilities as an owner. This includes keeping the dogs in their care under control at all times and ensuring the dogs do not attack any person or animal.

"This means the dog walker is responsible for deciding whether it is appropriate to walk any one or more particular dogs and can be held accountable if an incident occurs," says Angie.

The council's Dog Management Bylaw 2019 is currently undergoing a review, and regulations for commercial dog walkers are being considered as part of that process.

public feedback in early 2025.

'We would like to extend our condolences to the family who have lost their beloved dog and to reassure them that we are thoroughly investigating the incident," says Angie Castro.

If a member of the public encounters a dog behaving aggressively, or if they or their dog are attacked, Animal Management's advice is that they should retreat slowly to a safe space and phone the council on 09 301 0101 to report the incident, providing as much information as possible about the dog and owner.

Under the Dog Control Act, the owner of a dog that attacks can be fined up to \$3,000 in addition to any liability for any damage caused by the attack.

In some parts of the country, council bylaws limit the number of dogs a person can walk at a time.

A number of local dog walking businesses use the trail. Residents say these businesses walk dogs responsibly on leads and ensure they have control by not taking more than a few dogs at a time.

Locals say they don't want to see a ban on commercial dog walking, but they do want to spread awareness so that others can stay safe.

The decision of the three commissioners I find some of the logic behind the commissioners' thinking lacking in local knowledge and understanding. Realistically walking and cycling as a means of transport is unsustainable given busy, strenuous life these days in many cases.

I've come to the conclusion that the commissioners who I might say do have an important role in these circumstances. could not have been local residents or been well versed in the specifics of our very special rural/coastal area owing to some of the comments cited in this paper recently.

New roundabout designed to cope with truck and trailers, says AT

A new roundabout being constructed south of Clevedon has prompted some locals to question whether it will be navigable by large truck and trailer units, but Auckland Transport says it is up to the task.

AT spokesperson Natalie Polley says the design of two roundabouts being constructed as part of the new development area will allow vehicle sizes, including large bulk freight and quarry trucks.

"The roundabouts have been designed so that cars and trucks slow to a safe speed, coming from the rural highway into the built-up area. This is to encourage them to continue at a safe speed through the area, which is to become more populated as housing expands," says Natalie. "It will enable people on foot, on bikes, and on horses, to cross the road safely."

Conmara spokesperson Cameron Ross says he understands the roundabout looks small at present.

"However it is not completed. The roundabout has been designed in conjunction with AT so that it works for all vehicles including truck/trailer units. These days they design roundabouts with a 1.5m concrete edge that large truck and trailer units can drive over if need be. The concrete used is spec'd with a higher MPA to allow for heavy trucks."



Playcentre fights to save native tree

BMPC has requested that Playcentre Aotearoa send an arborist to assess the tree. "Their idea is that the tree can't be climbable, but this will be difficult to achieve as all the branches are so low," savs Olivia.

Using donated materials from Mitre 10 Beachlands, the centre had already constructed a boxed area around the base of the tree, to enclose an area of exposed

"The problem was the roots were a trip hazard," says Olivia. "So we boxed it, but then we were told the box framing itself is a trip hazard!"

The health and safety review also directed that BMPC replace its entire playground, at a cost of between \$14,000-17,000, plus a further \$6-10,000 to place 'soft fall' mulch on the ground around climbing areas.

The mulch, which must be certified, needs to be topped up every two years at a cost of around \$5,000.

"Playcentre is parent-run. We have guidelines and rules given to us by Playcentre Aotearoa. Fundraising is also up to us, so now we are exploring ways

to raise funds to replace our playground equipment," says Olivia.

Parents at the centre believe Playcentre Aotearoa's interpretation of the health and safety legislation has gone "way too far" in its attempt to remove risk.


"The whole philosophy behind Playcentre is that it is messsy, explorative, hands-on, child-led learning. Tree climbing being a big part of that," says Olivia. "Taking risks is also essential to building resilience."

BMPC coordinator Kendall McLaughlin is frustrated that the health and safety process is placing such high demands upon the volunteer-run centre.

"It's a shame that so much of our money, time and resource has to go into a tree. The money could be so much better used," says Kendall.

BMPC is now embarking on a mission to raise funds to replace playground items. So far they have received donations and support from Mitre 10, Rotary and the Takutai Charitable Trust, plus a few other local businesses, but there is still a long way to go.
