Auckland Council will be looking to implement rules for walking multiple dogs after a review found an overrepresentation in incidents.

At council's Regulatory and Community Safety Committee on 2 July, members endorsed the findings from a review of council's dog management bylaw and policy on dogs.

The review found that dog walkers with multiple dogs were over-represented when it came to incidents in shared spaces.

While the report said incidents were mostly low impact, the representation was disproportionate.

Dog walkers with multiple dogs made up 36 per cent of aggressive incidents and 31 per cent of chasing wildlife in shared spaces.

Chair Josephine Bartley asked if there was anything council could do about irresponsible dog walkers.

"We are having so many problems out there with dog walkers, even private individuals walking their dogs and not controlling their dogs that are off leash and they end up attacking other dogs," Bartley said.

She noted that commercial dog walking was unregulated and wondered if the bylaw could help.

Senior policy advisor Kylie Hill confirmed council would be investigating whether council could add rules for walking multiple dogs.

"We will be looking at investigating if there are options around potentially limiting the number of dogs that someone could walk," Hill said.

Council staff will prepare a number of

options to improve the bylaw and present these at the end of the year.

News of the proposed changes will be welcomed by local residents who have experienced frightening encounters with a Takaanini-based pack walking business. Whitford resident Barbara Wright's 13-year-old dog Kippa had to be euthanised after it was attacked by a group of dogs being pack-walked by Stimulated K9, a dog walking business.

Council prepares to engage public on pest control issues

A city councillor has admitted that pest but things are changing." plants such as woolly nightshade and moth plant are widespread on private land and that council finds it difficult to enforce removal of the plants due to cost.

At Auckland Council's Rural Advisory Panel on 2 August, panel members were asked to give their views on pest management for a number of key issues.

The council will start an initial phase of public engagement for the next Regional Pest Management Plan later this year. While the current plan will not lapse until 2030, the council reports the process can be lengthy, so it's beginning work now.

Biosecurity principal advisor Dr Imogen Bassett said while upcoming engagement would be quite targeted on specific issues, broader consultation would come later down the line.

"Pest pressures are not a static thing. They are changing over time; we have different things being brought into the council seemed to be missing another pest country," Bassett said.

She highlighted cat management, exotic caulerpa, freshwater gold clam and climate resilience as primary issues.

> Franklin Local Board member and Rural Advisory Panel member Alan Cole said a big issue for management was around landowners not managing pest species on private land.

> "Since the last plan came out, one of the things I'm noticing is the lack of ability to police people on private land around woolly nightshade and moth plant," Cole said.

Bassett said the early engagement would not look at that issue because the views were already quite clear.

"Woolly nightshade and moth plant are already very widespread in our region," Bassett said, estimating that it would cost millions of dollars to enforce compliance. She said it would be a question for elected members if they choose to put more funding into compliance.

Panel member Brian Mason said that the that impacts rural Aucklanders.

"The concern I've got is what can we do about pigs because pigs are a huge threat in North Eastern Rodney. We have got "We need to ask the general public about 20 to 30 pigs running in at night time in

do something there for us or can't they? Most farmers would be very happy to accommodate whatever was available," Mason said.

Bassett said most of the council's pig control was in the Waitakere Ranges.

"A lot of these questions are really a political question around how much

amongst a herd of cows. Can the council we invest in some of these things. The biosecurity act can give us a range of powers to do things like that," Bassett said.

Community lucky to escape unharmed from drunk driver

A crash in Kawakawa Bay could have ended in tragedy after the driver was found to be more than five times over the legal alcohol limit.

While the driver will face court, Police are sending a strong reminder about the dangers of driving while distracted and impaired.

The single vehicle crash occurred on Monday 5 August at around 5pm on Clevedon-Kawakawa Road, near Townson Road. The vehicle left the road and collided with a pole.

Power lines were brought down forcing the closure of one lane.

Counties Manukau South Area Commander, Inspector Joe Hunter says: "It is miraculous that the driver emerged from the vehicle unharmed, and that no other road user was hurt.

"The driver was spoken to, and it was established he was likely distracted by his mobile phone when he veered off the road."

Concerningly, the man also allegedly returned a breath alcohol reading of 1305mcg.

"It is very clear the alleged behaviour of this man put not only himself, but the community at risk," Inspector Hunter says.

"This road is a vital link between

the Kawakawa Bay and Clevedon communities, and at that time of the evening there are a number of people travelling."

Inspector Hunter says in the end the damage was only to a vehicle and power lines.

"Our staff could have likely been dealing with a loss of life, or medical professionals working to treat people with serious or life altering injuries.

"The message is so simple – if you're going to be drinking, do not get behind the wheel."

A 33-year-old Papakura man has been suspended from driving and will appear in court at a later date over the incident.

Alcohol related crashes contribute to around 15 per cent of deaths and serious injuries on Auckland's roads each year.

In the past 12 months Auckland Transport has worked with NZ Police to increase breath testing across Tāmaki Makaurau. There have been more breath tests conducted than any other time in the past decade, with more than 900,000 passive and screening breath tests undertaken between May 2023–April 2024.


Quay Gallery presents 'Shared Horizons', a solo exhibition by local artist Dalene Meiring.
