Guest editorial by MP for Papakura Rt Hon Judith Collins

Dear Constituents

It has been a busy year for us all and I hope that for most of you it has been a year that has brought hope of better things

For many of my constituents the future looks brighter with mortgage interest rates dropping and inflation back down below 3 per cent to 2.2 per cent in the September quarter, which is the lowest since March 2021.

New businesses, better public services

New businesses are opening, as I can confirm, having been invited to opening events at the Nauhria Pre-cast factory in Hūnua and Harcourts' new premises in Papakura, recently.

Better government services from housing availability to more effective tenant-landlord relationship management and more efficient law and order processes, are starting to be experienced.

There continues to be better assistance for children to attend school and positive changes for what they learn there. From January 2025, new programmes for reading, writing and maths will be rolled out in primary schools across the Papakura Electorate and the teaching staff have been receiving training to make this a positive experience for all for some months.

It takes a while for a new system to see positive results, but it is clear that the Minister of Health, Dr Shane Reti, is working hard to ensure that our health system is improving outcomes for patients.

There is more surgical space becoming available in Auckland south. Private facilities like those at Ormiston Medical Centre in Otara, have opened new hospital facilities that will provide for public referrals for urgent procedures and elective surgeries too.

Targets for faster specialist referrals and treatment of serious conditions like cancer and diabetes and the funding of new cutting-edge drugs, have started to make a positive difference to health outcomes for patients and their families.

Our science and technology sector has continued to make gains for our economy and is now our third biggest source of export returns. It is a sector that I am proud to represent especially because of the increased opportunities for employment and productivity it provides.

Local businesses are expanding their workforces through the increasing interest in science, technology and engineering in this community. I hope that students in their final years at schools in Papakura take advantage of visits that local employers offer. A school visit could lead to ideas for a career path and work experience or apprenticeships. In the growing industrial part of Ardmore Airport, Airbus NZ is establishing itself and it would welcome students from local secondary school students, as they can offer work experiences of all kinds in the business of sales, maintenance and construction of commercial aircraft especially helicopters.

Increasing Productivity

Our local building industry will benefit from the new construction consenting processes legislation that Minister for building and construction Chris Penk has tabled in Parliament. These will give professional builders greater powers to sign off minor routine building works and reduce the need for expensive Council inspections that may cause weeks of delay in the building process. This legislation has received bipartisan support from our Parliament.

This is great news for increasing the productivity and efficiency of the building industry and it has built in safeguards to ensure that high quality workmanship results in high quality finished homes.

Productivity and innovation are key to New Zealand's continued growth and improving GDP and recent trade deals signed include the May 2024 Free Trade Agreement with the European Union and the October 2024 agreement with Gulf Co-operation Council (GCC) countries of Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia and the UAE. This most recent one, will bring New Zealand's agricultural producers a market for \$1.8billion worth of dairy exports, \$260million worth of red meat including sheep meat, \$72million worth of horticulture and \$70million worth of tourism and travel. It offers many opportunities for growth for local businesses and producers and others across New Zealand.

Merry Christmas

With the advent of Christmas, I hope there will be time to plan for family times ahead. I hope you can put the Papakura Rotary Christmas Parade and Festival at Bruce Pullman Park, 30 Walters Road on Sunday 8 December 2024 from 11am, in your diaries.

My best wishes for the holidays and wonderful family times for Christmas and the New Year 2025.

Clevedon welcomes new community constable to the beat

Police Constable Lauren Dalley has stepped into the role of community constable serving Clevedon, Kawakawa Bay, Orere Point and surrounding areas.

Lauren has worked on the frontline for NZ Police for the past three years within Counties Manukau, and says she looks forward to dedicating her time to a smaller, more specific area.

The change from frontline policing to community policing will also allow her to work from a proactive perspective, rather than a responsive one, she says.

Lauren grew up in Wellington, and spent ten years living in the UK and Singapore before travelling through South America on her way back to Aotearoa. She now lives in Papakura.

Lauren is keen to meet people from the local community to chat about any initiatives that could be beneficial for the area.

"Initially I just want to get out and meet people, and I'll let things unfold from there."

At some point in the future, Lauren is keen to investigate the possibility of running a fortnightly drop-in session within Clevedon.

Lauren's time will be divided between Takaanini, Papakura and Clevedon.

"I'm not always in the area, so it's important for people to remember the importance of reporting things via 111 for emergencies, or 105 for less urgent matters. And it's really important that people do report things - if we aren't made aware, we can't respond appropriately," says Lauren.

Hūnua School students lead the way in environmental action

After six years of putting the mahi into environmental initiatives, staff and students at Hūnua School have been awarded their Green Gold Enviroschool accreditation.

The Green Gold Enviroschool award is the highest award given by Enviroschools to schools that demonstrate a commitment to sustainability and environmental protection.

At Hūnua, students have poured their efforts into a range of environmental projects over the years, guided at times by mentors from outside the school including a PhD student, rangitahi working in the Hūnua Ranges, and local conservationist Lenny van Heugten.

When pest control efforts began at the school, there were plenty of rats about. Fisher & Paykel came on board, holding workshops to teach students about simple machines and forces in motion, allowing the students to make their own pest control traps. The traps were a success one even caught a rat which measured in at a whopping 42cm.

Over time pest numbers have declined to the point that the school has not caught anything in its traps this year.

As pest numbers have declined, students have focussed on raising bird numbers at the school, assisted by funding grants. Enviro champion and teacher Nola White says bird life is now flourishing,

with annual bird counts revealing an increase in native bird populations. Tui are commonly spotted around the school.

"A few weeks ago, we had two parakeets tapping on our window, just sitting there, watching the children. And we've had four kereru out on the power lines here just watching the kids come and go. It's fabulous," says Nola.

Planting is another aspect the students have enjoyed, says Nola. The school partners with Trees for Survival to plant native trees in the community,

and children have established vegetable gardens and native planting areas around the school.

During this year's conservation week, Nola says every student in the school planted a tree.

Older students mentor younger students, passing on the mantle as they graduate and head to secondary school. Te Ao Maori underpins much of the learning, and environmental aspects are incorporated into everyday learning.

A passionate group of middle and senior

students make up the school's Enviro Committee, looking after birdlife and insects and ensuring as much waste as possible is recycled.

It is a lot of work, but Nola believes the results speak for themselves.

"We do this to get the children to be environmentally conscious. It's actually empowering them to take action. It takes a bit of putting together, but it's worth it."

Public invited to have their say on Beachlands wastewater discharge resource consent application

Watercare Services Limited has submitted a resource consent application to Auckland Council, seeking approval for a discharge permit for treated wastewater from its Beachlands Wastewater Treatment Plant (BWWTP). The proposal outlines a four-stage plan to manage the discharge of wastewater in Beachlands and Maraetai over the next 35 years.

The application seeks to replace the current discharge permit, which expires in December 2025, and includes a staged approach:

Stage 1: Continuation of current operations at the BWWTP, with a daily discharge volume limit of 4,500m³ to support up to 11,000 residents.

Stage 2: Short-term upgrades to expand capacity for 18,000 residents. Improvements include better aeration, expanded overland flow areas, upgraded filtration, and new sludge drying beds.

Stages 3 and 4: Long-term upgrades to replace the existing lagoon with advanced membrane bioreactor (MBR) systems, which provide near-complete removal

of solids and microorganisms. This will support up to 30,000 residents with a daily discharge limit of 36,200m³.

During all stages, treated wastewater will be discharged via an overland flow system into groundwater and a tributary of the Te Puru Stream.

The upgrades are designed to accommodate population growth in Beachlands and surrounding areas, including the recently approved Beachlands South development and the proposed Pōhutukawa Business Park at the site of the existing Beachlands Quarry. Both projects were initially planned

with separate wastewater systems, but Watercare believes it would be more efficient to integrate them into the Beachlands plant.

The preferred discharge option — spreading treated wastewater over a 4-6ha field before it filters into the Te Puru Stream — was chosen after consultation with the community and mana whenua.

Watercare's application has been publicly notified by Auckland Council. Residents have until 16 December to give feedback at aucklandcouncil.govt.nz/have-yoursay.

Supporters are encouraged to join the Hūnua Volunteer Fire Brigade on Saturday 30 November between 10am and 4pm at the Hunua Village green as brigade members 'MO've for Movember' in support of men's mental health.

The team plans to support the worthy charity event by walking 60km in full firefighting breathing apparatus - one kilometer for each of the 60 men who take their lives every hour globally.

Some of the brigade will accumulate their 60km over the month and finish it on the day, some have teamed up and will share the load in a relay style event, and some absolute "mad dogs" will complete the full 60km on the day. Walkers will follow the 1.3km Lockwood Rd and Hūnua Road loop.

People are welcome to bring their walking shoes and join the brigade as they walk. They will even have some spare firefighting kit for people who fancy doing an extra challenging lap or two.
