Guest editorial

Auckland can accommodate plenty of growth. The question is whether that growth happens in places where the roads, pipes, public transport and other services are ready for it.

That is where I have had a serious problem with the Government’s fast-track consenting system.

Fast-track has a useful purpose. Nationally significant infrastructure and other worthwhile projects should not be held up unnecessarily.

But it should not allow Wellington to approve large new communities in places Auckland has not planned for, while leaving existing Auckland ratepayers to pick up the cost.

The Government did finally accept there was a problem and changed the law.

Councils can now amend their development-contribution policies where fast-track developments create growth-related infrastructure costs that were not anticipated.

That is sensible, because growth should pay for growth.

But the change does not solve the whole problem, and for some projects it has come too late.

The new provisions do not apply to developments that had already been

approved when the law came into force. They also exclude projects where an applicant had already received a draft decision or draft conditions.

That means Auckland ratepayers could still be left with costs from developments already well advanced through the fast-track process.

And development contributions deal only with eligible capital costs. They do not cover the ongoing expense of servicing thousands of additional homes in areas where Auckland did not expect them.

New communities create demand for public transport and a range of council services. There are also ongoing costs from things such as illegal dumping, noise control and animal management.

Auckland Council therefore has to consider what services it can realistically provide where developments are approved outside the areas in which growth has been planned and funded.

There is another odd feature of the system.

Fast-track is supposed to get projects moving, yet some greenfield developments have been given as long as eight years to start. That is longer than an ordinary resource consent.

The Delmore development decision

shows how strange the outcome can become: more than 1,200 homes fast-tracked without a connection to Watercare’s wastewater network, with the possibility of wastewater being transported by tanker north to Whangārei.

There are also questions about whether every applicant granted approval has the resources to actually build a project of that scale.

If a fast-track approval is intended to accelerate construction, it should go to someone capable of delivering the development. It should not become an asset that can simply be obtained and sold on. That is why I believe these approvals should be non-transferable.

None of this means Auckland needs to stop growing.

Major developers will tell you there are years of development opportunities already available within Auckland without continually pushing further into rural areas.

We should be concentrating growth where infrastructure exists or is already planned, rather than creating new liabilities for ratepayers.

Get that decision wrong and the consequences last for decades. Roads, pipes, public transport and council services all have to follow.

The Government has recognised one flaw in fast-track and is fixing it.

Whatever the make-up of the next government is, they’ll need to deal with the much bigger question: who pays when Wellington approves growth Auckland has neither planned nor funded?

Seven years on, Sunkist Bay seawall repairs on the horizon

The long-awaited renewal of the Sunkist Bay eastern seawall has moved a step closer, with Auckland Council confirming the physical works tender was released in June 2026 and contractor negotiations are now underway.

The project was first approved back in February 2019 after coastal storms damaged the tipped rock seawall the previous year. It has faced repeated delays, from Covid-19 disruptions to lengthy consenting requirements. Resource consent was finally issued in May 2025, with Stage 1 works (the rock revetment

rebuild, step repairs, western headland structure and boat ramp renewal) expected to go to tender at the start of this year.

According to Auckland Council’s General Manager Engineering, Assets and Technical Advisory Paul Klinac, tenders for the physical works were received and evaluated in July 2026, and the Council is now in commercial discussions with a preferred contractor. Klinac says the Council is hopeful these discussions will have wrapped up by the end of September, followed by an announcement about the contractor and a full construction programme.

“This work will address the coastal erosion risk in the bay and will provide improved access to the foreshore and water,” says Klinac.

Council says it is unable to share detailed cost figures while commercial negotiations are ongoing. However, Klinac indicated the project remains on budget, with the Council “still aiming to deliver the project within the agreed budget of \$2.25 million” for Stage 1. Cost estimates back in 2025 ranged from \$2.1–2.6 million, a substantial increase from the original \$935,000 estimate.

Funding for the high-risk erosion elements of the project will come from council’s Regional Coastal Renewals Programme for this financial year, Klinac says.

While the physical seawall repairs have taken years to be actioned, council continues to monitor the wall and carry out repairs as needed to protect public safety and access. No further storm damage or deterioration has been recorded since the 2025 assessment that would change the scope of the planned works.

Coastal Community Garden blossoms

As the days begin to warm and spring approaches, volunteers at the Coastal Community Garden have been hard at work preparing for another productive growing season.

Members of the Gardeners Club have spent recent weeks enriching garden beds with fresh compost and sheep pellets, ensuring the soil is nutrient-rich and ready for a season of strong growth. Their efforts continue to build on a successful winter harvest that has kept a steady supply of fresh produce available to the community.

Despite the cooler months, the garden has remained remarkably productive, with crops including spinach, broccoli, perennial basil, lettuces and a variety of other leafy greens thriving throughout winter.

One of the newest additions to the garden is a purpose-built strawberry bed located near the front entrance. Constructed from recycled timber by dedicated volunteer Darryl Hicks, the new bed is already drawing attention from visitors. Garden members are eagerly anticipating a bumper strawberry harvest during the warmer summer months.

The garden has also seen a change in its landscape, with a former karaka tree being replaced by a lemon tree. The new

citrus addition is expected to become a popular feature, providing a ready supply of lemons for winter favourites such as hot lemon and honey drinks.

Community education remains an important part of the garden’s activities. On 1 November at 3pm, the Coastal Community Garden will host a Seed and Seedling Swap, inviting gardeners of all ages and experience levels to bring along spare seeds or seedlings to exchange with others. Organisers say the event is a great opportunity to introduce new varieties into home gardens, share knowledge and connect with fellow gardening enthusiasts. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Looking further ahead, the Gardeners Club is working alongside Auckland Council on plans to develop a larger community garden behind Beachlands Hall on Wakelin Road. The project is still in its early stages, but organisers are enthusiastic about the possibilities and encourage residents to keep an eye out for future announcements.

With thriving winter crops, exciting new additions and ambitious plans for expansion, the Coastal Community Garden continues to demonstrate how community collaboration can cultivate not only fresh food, but also stronger neighbourhood connections.

Add Nusa Lembongan to your Bali bucket list

Just a short (and sometimes hairy) boat ride from mainland Bali, Nusa Lembongan offers a laid-back island escape a world away from the chaos of Seminyak or Canggu, but still with Bali's legendary food, cheap massages and good waves.

Getting there

It's worth starting and ending your trip with a night or two in Sanur, located on the mainland coast an easy 20-minute taxi ride from Bali's international airport. Sanur offers a more laid-back vibe than the tourist-teeming hot spots, but still with an overwhelming array of highly-rated places to eat and drink. Start the day with a smoothie bowl that's more like a work of art at Blend Cafe, enjoy a patisserie lunch by the sea at Byrdhouse, and finish the day off with a fun cocktail and tasty bites at Shotgun Social. Sanur's oceanside boardwalk stretches far enough along the coast to let you walk off the indigestion, and there are accommodation options for all budgets.

Getting to Nusa Lembongan

Ferries depart regularly from Sanur Harbour, which lies north of Sanur township. Ferry tickets can be pre-booked online (baliferries.com) and cost about NZ\$20 each way to the island. Ocean swells and cramped seating can make the short crossing to the island seem a lot longer, so catching an early morning ferry while the weather is calmer is a solid plan.

Getting around

Part of Nusa Lembongan's charm is the lack of cars. There's no Grab or Gojek (Indonesia's versions of Uber) here, so most visitors get around by scooter or open-air taxi. For families or anyone after a bit more safety and stability, hiring a buggy is one of the best ways to explore. Nusa Lembongan Buggy Hire offers 5-seater buggies for around NZ\$100 a day, and it's a fun way to discover the island's quieter corners. Allow the best part of a day to stop at beaches and cafes, and perhaps

a kayak tour of the island's mangrove forest.

Getting in the water

With four distinct surf breaks - Playgrounds, Lacerations, Razors, and Shipwrecks - Nusa Lembongan has waves to suit everyone from total beginners to experienced surfers. Local surf schools cater to all levels, and know exactly which spots suit your ability and the day's conditions. The island's clear water is also good for snorkelling and spotting manta rays at nearby Manta Point, although currents can be strong and waves treacherous - only go with a reputable operator, and if you're a confident swimmer. Don't be afraid to pull the pin if weather and sea conditions aren't favourable on the day.

Where to eat and drink

Within the lively Jungut Batu area, you'll find something to suit all palates and budgets.

Where to stay

If you don't mind a touch of luxury, Villa Shambala is hard to beat. Perched on a clifftop at Lembongan's famous Sunset Point, the five-bedroom villa boasts the island's largest infinity pool, with each room offering sweeping 270-degree ocean views. Sleeping 14, it's ideally suited to families or groups of friends, with ensuite bathrooms in every room, a bar and pool table for rainy-day entertainment, and the occasional treat of spotting dolphins, turtles or manta rays from the deck. Staff are on hand to help with any guest requirements. A short walk from the villa takes you down the hill to beautiful Mushroom Bay where restaurants and small hotels frame a picture-perfect beach.

Nusa Lembongan delivers all the food, fun and natural beauty Bali is famous for, minus the traffic and crowds. It's worth carving a few days out of any Bali itinerary for.

Twenty-four hours in Zurich



Located next to Google's Zurich headquarters is the Hürlimannbad & Spa, offering a serene escape from the big city buzz.

They call it the most expensive city in the world, and they are not wrong, but it does make a convenient launching point for a European holiday. And you can still hang about Zurich for a day without breaking the bank.

Begin your day with a freshly baked pastry from local supermarket Migros, then catch a train to the Adliswil-Felsenegg cable car, which is not a tourist gig but rather an ordinary part of the city's public transport, covered by the same ticket that gets you anywhere else. In under six minutes it lifts you three hundred metres out of the Sihl Valley and deposits you somewhere with a view of Lake Zurich and the Alps beyond.

At the top, fuel up with some fondue and a spritz on the panoramic terrace of the Felsenegg restaurant before embarking on the six-kilometre ridge walk along the Albis chain toward Uetliberg. The trail is gentle and well-marked, passing through forest and then meadow and then forest again, before arriving at one of the finest views the city has to offer, and an easy train

ride back down into the world of high finance and luxury brand stores.

Take an ice cream on the lakefront, check out a museum if you wish, then round out your day at Hürlimannbad & Spa, formed around the stoney industrial bones of an old brewery. Included in the entry price is a self-guided journey through a 10-step Roman spa ritual traversing steam rooms, exfoliating scrubs, warm stone relaxation tables, hot pools, hotter pools, cold pools and massage pools. Your skin remembers Rotorua, but the smell is better. After you've worked your way through the 10 steps, throw on your robe and head to the rooftop where a stainless steel infinity pool overlooks the city going about its ordinary Tuesday below you. Then bring yourself back down to earth with a cocktail and snack served in the comfort of the spa's bistro.

Hotels aren't cheap in Zurich but you'll find a slightly more affordable mattress somewhere out of town near the city's Swissly-efficient train network.

A day or two is enough to see the city's sights before ducking off to slightly less expensive pastures.

The world through the eye of a traveller ... and a travel professional

After more than 35 years in the travel industry, and having travelled to 49 countries across 6 continents, I've had the privilege of experiencing travel in many different ways. This year has been a particularly interesting year for European travel. Weather events, changing river conditions, flight disruptions, transport delays and other unexpected issues have affected travellers across the continent.

When everything goes according to plan, booking your own holiday can seem very straightforward. But when something goes wrong, that's often when the value of an experienced travel professional really becomes apparent.

My job doesn't finish when the tickets are issued. If a flight changes, a connection is missed, a tour is disrupted or circumstances require a change of plans, I'm there to help work through the options with suppliers and find a practical solution.

After 49 countries, 4 recent European trips and more than 3 decades in the industry, I've learned that travel is above so much more than getting from A to B. It's about understanding the journey as a whole, matching it to the individual traveller and having someone who knows what to do when the unexpected happens.

Plane sailing: how the other half fly

I have long since made peace with the back of the plane. The dream of business class had, like so many fantasies at the age of fifty-five, quietly died and been buried without ceremony.

And then. Qatar Airways placed me on a waiting list for a business class seat to Europe, a small transactional kindness in exchange for telling *Pōhutukawa Coast Times* readers about the delights of lie-flat seats and indulgent menus.

On the day of travel a few seats emptied themselves out, and the waiting list became the thing itself. And now here I am, reporting back through my economy-tinted eyes, blinking in the sudden light.

It is every bit as good as you've heard, and I say this even knowing the airline paid for my praise, or tried to. Qatar Airways' Q Suites offer travellers their own cubicled nest, screened off from the eyes and irritating coughs of other passengers. The seat unfolds into a bed. Champagne and hot towels arrive like small apologies for every discomfort you have ever endured in a middle seat. The a la carte menu is available at any hour you like. If the flight is long enough, and your stomach is stretchy enough, you can eat your way through the entire card.

Some genetic weakness makes me love small expensive lotions in small expensive tubes, so the Diptyque amenity kit was a delight, as were the gifted pyjamas, soft as an unearned business class seat.

I slept, an experience previously unknown to me at 40,000 feet.

The excess continued on the ground in Doha, with Qatar Airways' Al Maha Service where a dedicated host whisked us past the long unmoving rivers of economy passengers, into a lounge with hot food and showers and a view over the airport's tropical interior garden. Hamad International has been named the best airport in the Middle East eleven years running, and best airport shopping for the third year in a row, according to people whose job it is to rank such things.

Qatar Airways can get you from Auckland to a number of handy European cities five times a week, and in 2025 was named World's Best Airline for the ninth time, along with World's Best Business Class, World's Best Business Class Airline Lounge, and Best Airline in the Middle East for the thirteenth.

Fares cost anywhere from \$1300 one-way (economy), to just under \$5,000 one-way (business class).

Thai red curry roasted snapper fillets

Fishing season is upon us. Here is a quick, easy and tasty way to serve fresh-caught snapper.

Serves 2

Ingredients

- 1 Tablespoon red curry paste
- 1/4 cup coconut cream
- 1 tsp fish sauce
- Juice of half a lime
- 2 snapper fillets (skin on or off)

Method

1. Mix curry paste, coconut cream, fish sauce and lime juice together well in a cup.
2. Line air fryer basket with baking paper, and place the two snapper fillets inside the basket.
3. Baste fillets with the curry paste until thickly coated.
4. Air fry at 180 degrees for 8-10 minutes, until fish is cooked through.
5. Serve with a fresh green salad and baby potatoes.

My Two Homes, One Heart

In 2003, my parents moved from India to New Zealand. They packed their clothes and belongings, but they also brought something much more important: their culture, traditions, and dreams for the future. Thirteen years later, I was born in New Zealand. My speech is about how my parents and the two cultures are shaping my life. Growing up, I sometimes felt a bit confused. I wondered where I truly belonged. Am I a Kiwi or am I Indian? Today, I know the answer. I am proudly both.

Every second year, during the end-of-year holidays, we travel to India to visit our family. I love seeing my grandparents, cousins, aunties, and uncles. Sometimes it feels like every room is full! When I am there, I feel connected to my family and to where my parents came from. When I visit India, many of my relatives speak Punjabi. Sometimes I wish I could speak it as well as they do. One day, while sitting with my grandparents and looking through old family photos, they told me stories about my parents when they were children. As I listened, I realised something important. Even though I don't speak perfect Punjabi and I have never lived in India, those stories are still part of my story. That was the moment I understood that my roots are not just about where I live or what language I speak. They are about family, memories, and knowing where I come from.

Even though I love visiting India, I also love coming home to New Zealand. We live on a lifestyle block, which is very different from the busy places in India. One of my favourite things to do is help look after my calves. Feeding them and caring for them has taught me responsibility and patience. I love the open spaces, the fresh air, and the peaceful life my family has created here. New Zealand is also where my friends are. My mum teaches me to believe in myself, work hard, and never give up. My dad has given me a love for the outdoors and taught me to be adventurous and try new things. For a long time, I thought India was where my roots were and New Zealand was where I lived. Now I understand that it is not that simple. One gives me my family, traditions, and stories, and the other gives me my opportunities, friendships, and the life I love. I am proud to be both an Indian and a Kiwi. My roots are in both places, my voice is my own, and my future will be shaped by everything they have taught me.
