Coast youth have a ball

The first ever Pōhutukawa Coast Youth Ball, hosted by the Pōhutukawa Coast Youth Council (PCYC), was a big success on Saturday 29 August, bringing together 125 young people aged 15–19 at Rydges Formosa Golf Resort.

The sold-out event was a chance for teens from different schools and areas to reconnect and make new friendships.

PCYC Chairperson Blake Ingram, who co-organised the event with Event Manager Charlotte Smith, says the night exceeded every expectation.

"Seeing young people from all different schools come together, laugh, dance, and feel completely at home was incredible," says Blake says. "That's what this ball was all about - creating a safe, inclusive space where everyone could reconnect and enjoy a great night out."

The Pōhutukawa Coast Youth Council is a community-led organisation that empowers young people to design events and initiatives that strengthen youth wellbeing and belonging. The Youth Ball was organised after a community survey revealed that local teens were keen for a more formal event.

The Youth Council say that despite stormy weather on the night, the atmosphere inside was full of energy, with friends catching up and new connections forming. The evening included a buffet Italian dinner provided by Rydges Formosa Golf Resort, a photo booth, and a DJ who kept the dance floor full all night.

Event Manager Charlotte Smith says the ball achieved exactly what the Youth Council set out to create. "It didn't matter which school you were from or where you lived; everyone aged 15–19 was invited, and that inclusiveness is what made the night so special," she says.

The Youth Council thanks its supporters - Auckland Council, Franklin Local Board, Rydges Formosa Golf Resort, and Sisters on Wakelin - for making the event possible, and is already looking forward to bringing the Ball back again next year.

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Whitford Stories returns with story of the Broomfields

Episode 3 of the local historical film series *Whitford Stories* will screen at The Stables on Monday 7 September at 7pm.

The latest film, *The Broomfields*, brings to life another fascinating chapter in the history of Whitford and the pioneering families who helped establish the community originally known as Turanga.

The 30-minute film is the third episode of *Whitford Stories*, a series telling the stories of some of the first European settlers in the district.

At the centre of the new episode are William and Elizabeth Broomfield.

Elizabeth Broomfield became a strong community pioneer and leader and lived on Broomfields Road until she was in her mid-nineties. The cottage built by Elizabeth and her husband William still stands at the end of Broomfields Road today and remains occupied.

William Broomfield was a mariner who not only sailed the local waters but also built vessels used for transport around the Howick, Whitford and Maraetai coastline.

Both William and Elizabeth Broomfield were adventurous types. William visited NZ several times in the Royal Navy before settling here and becoming a fugitive being sought by the Fencible Guard in Howick. They were probably the first couple married in the All Saints Church in Howick.

Elizabeth was a great community leader and community builder. She had a strong relationship with local Māori, having learned to reo Māori as a child growing up with them in Parnell, before moving to Waikopua in the mid 1800s.

The film covers a lot of events in both of their lives including a story where Elizabeth is credited with possibly saving the young settlement of Howick from an invasion by warring Māori.

The film also reveals an interesting connection between the Broomfield family and the Trice Brothers, whose story featured in the first episode of *Whitford Stories*.

Filmmaker and long-time Whitford resident Dale Bradley has spent almost 12 months creating *The Broomfields*.

Dale describes *Whitford Stories* as a passion project and says the production has also given him an opportunity to explore new AI screen-production techniques.

“These days in my profession I am normally hiring skilful and talented people to do the actual filmmaking process,” Bradley says. “This is a great opportunity for me to do as much of the production and technical work myself. Instead of being a manager, I’m a hands-on filmmaker again. And I really love it!”

The series aims to preserve the stories and memories of Whitford and present them to today’s audiences using contemporary filmmaking and distribution techniques.

Its wider objective is to strengthen people’s connection with their community and ensure that local stories are recorded for future generations.

“Learning about our heritage is an important aspect of community building,” Bradley says. “We need to tell these stories today, using the medium and distribution methods of our age.”

Dale has worked professionally as a storyteller for more than 40 years, producing more than 35 feature films and television drama series, directing nine feature films and writing seven produced film scripts. He has worked with an extensive list of international performers and personalities.

NZ First’s Papakura candidate steps down

George Ngatai QSM has withdrawn as New Zealand First’s candidate for Papakura ahead of November’s general election, citing threats he says amount to potential blackmail or extortion.

Ngatai, a former Vision New Zealand candidate, Destiny Church member and owner of Radio Aotearoa, says he has referred the matter to police. The dispute stems from messages allegedly sent by radio host Martel Wikeepa, known as “Shubz,” who had presented a voluntary show on Ngatai’s station before being suspended last week following an employment dispute.

Messages published on the Shubz Live Facebook page appear to show Ngatai contacting ACT leader David Seymour and Opportunities Party leader Qiulae Wong earlier this year about possible meetings, though none took place. Ngatai says demands for payment were later linked to threats to release private information.

Ngatai’s wife, Manurewa Local Board member Raewyn Bhana QSM, recently went public with allegations of electoral fraud involving stolen ballot papers in last year’s local body election, and says she has also received threats since speaking out.

Ngatai says he is stepping aside to avoid becoming a distraction for the party. New Zealand First confirmed it accepted his resignation and wished him well.

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Touch comes to Clevedon

A brand-new touch rugby module is launching at the Clevedon Showgrounds, with opening night set for 30 October, then running every Friday evening through to the start of March.

The initiative has come from a group of local parents, whose sons began playing touch in Karaka last year and rippa rugby over winter for Ardmore Marist.

“We collectively agreed that it would be amazing if we could utilise the facilities in Clevedon to run touch a little closer to home this year and start getting more of the community involved in sports locally as well,” says committee spokesperson Jordan Ingles. “Touch is such a great feeder sport into other sports, and to have the backing of the Wairoa Rangers, we hope it will lead to growth for them and in future maybe a rippa/rugby season at home as well.”

The module is designed to welcome the whole community, regardless of experience. Grades will start out mixed, though Jordan says they may look at introducing separate male/female grades as the module grows.

The committee hopes to attract 200–300 players across the season. Teams need a minimum of six players, with two females required on the field at all times, while senior teams are capped at 12 players per squad.

Coaching and training are entirely up

to individual teams, who can decide how competitive they want to be.

“The module is as competitive as people want to make it,” says Jordan.

Junior players can register individually for \$50, which includes a team shirt.

Senior grades (covering both adults and under-16s) can register as a full team for \$400, with fees going toward prize money for the winning team. All registration fees cover ground hire, referees for the older grades, medals for junior grades, and prize money for senior grades.

Registrations run for the full season, though organisers say they’ll still accept new players joining existing teams as the module progresses. All equipment will be provided - players just need to bring their boots and a good attitude. Food trucks will be on site each Friday.

While this year is being run as a trial, the goal is for the module to become an annual fixture on Clevedon’s summer sporting calendar. The Wairoa Rangers are supporting the initiative through its first year, and organisers hope that as the module grows, it could eventually run as an official Touch NZ module.

Registrations are open now and close on 9 October. Anyone interested in signing up a team or individual player is encouraged to get in early. For full details see clevedontouchrugby.com.

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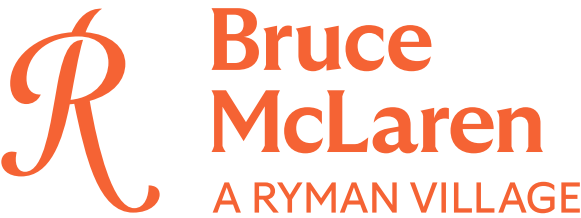

FOOD AND ENTERTAINMENT

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Serves 1

Ingredients:

- Dough**
½ cup flour
½ tsp baking powder
2 tsp sugar
1 tsp cinnamon
Pinch of salt
40 mls milk
1 Tbsp butter
1/2 tsp vanilla essence

- Coating**
1 Tbsp melted butter
1 Tbsp sugar
2 tsp cinnamon

- Icing**
1 Tbsp cream cheese
1 Tbsp icing sugar
1 tsp milk

- Method:**
1. Combine all the dry dough ingredients in a bowl. Heat the milk and butter together until melted, add in vanilla. Combine the milk mix with the dry ingredients and stir until the dough just comes together.
 2. Roll out the dough into a long sausage shape, cut into around 2 cm wide pieces.
 3. Mix the coating ingredients together. Place the dough pieces into the coating mixture and stir until evenly coated.
 4. Lay the coated dough pieces in a small baking dish. Bake for 8-10 minutes in the air fryer at 180°C. The dough should be cooked through and golden on top.
 5. In a separate bowl mix the cream cheese, icing sugar and milk together, until smooth.
 6. Drizzle the icing over the dough and you are ready to enjoy!
