Supermarket confirmed for Clevedon

Clevedon residents who have long hoped for a local supermarket will be happy to hear that Clevedon developer Conmara Estate has signed an agreement with Foodstuffs to develop a new 600m² Four Square.

The Four Square will sit within Conmara North, a new subdivision to be built on the western side of the village, on the block of land that lies between Papakura Clevedon Road and Twilight Road.

The developers behind Conmara Estate say the agreement with Foodstuffs addresses a growing need in Clevedon for additional commercial and retail services.

The new supermarket's proposed site is near the intersection of Monument and Papakura Clevedon Roads, near the existing Clevedon Gourmet shop. It is part of an existing resource consent application to develop Conmara North into a residential development, with stage 1 offering 94 residential lots and 4 rural lots. Once fully developed, the wider Conmara North development is expected to provide about 160 residential lots and 10 rural lots in total. Early concept plans also show a commercial and retail precinct, though final building designs, materials and colours may change as planning progresses.

Conmara developer Cameron Ross, whose family has lived in the region for five generations, says Conmara Estate North will be similar to its sister development, Conmara South,

offering rural views, similar road widths, and matching covenants to create a consistent look and feel across the wider Conmara Estate.

"A key focus of the planning has been offering lot sizes to suit a range of homes and lifestyles. Lot sizes will range from 549m² up to more than 6,000m², with more than half of the residential lots sized at 800m² or larger, alongside plenty of smaller options below that," says Cameron. "Every residential lot will have a street frontage of at least 15.5 metres on the smaller lots, giving buyers a mix of easy-care sections, generous family sites, and larger estate-style properties to choose from."

Cameron says Conmara North will have the same high standard of planning, design and delivery.

The project still has some way to go through Auckland Council's Resource Consent process, but the developers are hopeful of having resource consent approval by mid 2027, with earthworks commencing late 2027, and titles available by early 2029 - all subject to Council approvals and construction progress.

Completion of the supermarket and retail/commercial precinct is estimated to be by mid-2029.

Conmara's journey so far has involved over a decade of

Clevedon Village’s plans gather momentum

Clevedon’s long-awaited town centre upgrade is a step closer with detailed designs progressing on the \$2.8 million project and public consultation expected next month.

Since consulting on the concept plan in 2024, Franklin Local Board has successfully secured \$1.2m through Auckland Council’s \$20 million Fix and Finish Fund, helping fast-track the project towards delivery.

At its 1 September 2026 workshop, the board received an update on draft designs developed with community feedback front of mind.

Franklin Local Board Chair Alan Cole says securing the funding was a significant milestone.

“We were thrilled to secure this funding, as it was only available to projects that were ready to progress and in parts of Auckland within the former Manukau City Council area,” he says.

“This investment brings us much closer to delivering the vibrant village centre Clevedon deserves. We’re looking forward to sharing the detailed designs and hearing what the community thinks before construction gets underway.”

The proposed upgrade includes a reconfigured off-street parking area, improvements to the play area, a new green space, new public toilets, and a bike hub to better welcome recreational cyclists and visitors.

Community feedback has already shaped the plans with additional play features to cater to a wide range of ages, shelter and shade sails over the picnic

area and more.

Residents will have another opportunity to have their say when detailed designs go out for consultation in October 2026.

Construction is expected to begin in May 2027.

Keep an eye out for the upcoming design reveal and details on how to get involved.

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Sanctuary St James series announces music line-up

Clevedon’s much-loved Sanctuary St James concert series is back this spring, bringing four evenings of live music to the All Souls Church, starting Sunday 20 September.

Presented by the Anglican Parish of Clevedon, the series takes its name from St James Church in Ardmore, which is now closed to the public due to structural issues. In its place, Clevedon’s All Souls Church, dedicated in 1861, has stepped up as host.

The 2026 season kicks off on Sunday 20 September at 7pm with Unsung Heroes, a theatrical music group who bring New Zealand’s settler history to life through song, narration and a photographic slideshow of historic images. Performer Peter Elliott is on narration and percussion, accompanied by a line-up including guitar, slide guitar, seven-string guitar and ukulele.

On Sunday 27 September, Wellington duo WindWood take the stage, pairing the warm tones of the marimba with the flute family’s rich colour palette. Formed by longtime friends and Orchestra Wellington section principals Karen Batten and Jeremy Fitzsimons, the duo made a strong impression at the 2021 Classical on Cuba Festival.

Sunday 4 October sees the return of chamber music with The Jade String Quartet, led by violinist Miranda Adams alongside Charmian Keay, Robert Ashworth and James Yoo. Recognised as among the country’s most accomplished string players, the quartet is known for championing both new New Zealand compositions and the great works of the international repertoire.

Closing out the season on Sunday 11 October is the Canadian-New Zealand pairing of violinist Andrew Sords and pianist Cheryl Duvall, whose international touring has drawn glowing reviews.

All concerts run for one hour and begin at 7pm at All Souls Church, Clevedon. Tickets for the opening concert are \$35 (including supper), with concerts two through four priced at \$30 each. Music lovers wanting to catch the whole season can buy a full-season pass for \$105.

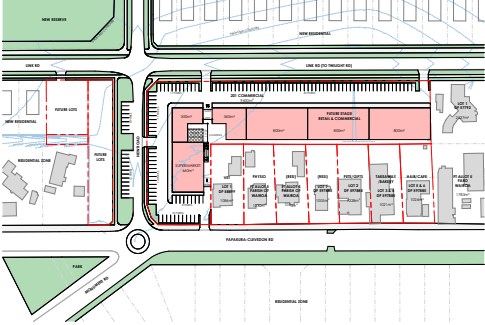


Concept image of Conmara North’s retail precinct. Image supplied.

planning and consulting, says Cameron. The land was purchased in 2011, five years before the Clevedon provisions of the Auckland Unitary Plan were formally introduced in 2016. Conmara was one of the parties involved in Clevedon Infrastructure Services Limited, which was established by local landowners to help bring reticulated water and wastewater services to Clevedon and support the village’s planned growth.

The original concept for Conmara North provided for approximately 260 homes, however changes to wetland regulations (along with other planning

and environmental requirements) mean the design has changed significantly. “Addressing these changes requires considerable time and specialist consultant input, all of which contributes to the increasing cost of developing land and delivering new housing,” says Cameron.

Interview with ACT Party
Candidate for the Botany
electorate, Ali Dahche.

How will you make sure the Pōhutukawa Coast’s rural, coastal communities aren’t overlooked?

My commitment is that every part of the Botany electorate will have a strong voice, including Whitford, Beachlands and Maraetai.

The Pōhutukawa Coast has its own character and challenges, and representation shouldn’t simply follow population size. These communities deserve an MP who is visible, listens to local residents, and understands the pressures that come with growth, and represents those needs to parliament.

Practically, that means regularly being in the area, meeting residents, businesses and community organisations, and taking local concerns back to Parliament. Listen locally, advocate strongly, follow through.

How do you see growth, like Beachlands South, being balanced against infrastructure and community character?

I do love that golf course, but we also

have to be realistic about the growth Auckland is experiencing. The city’s population has doubled since the early 1980s and is expected to reach two million within the next decade. People want to live here, and we need to make room for them.

The real question is whether we manage that growth well. Beachlands South could bring a significant number of new homes, but you can’t just build thousands of houses and hope everything else catches up. The roads, water, wastewater, schools and public transport all need to be part of the plan from the beginning.

That’s where I strongly believe growth should pay for growth. Existing residents in Beachlands and Maraetai shouldn’t be handed the bill through their rates for infrastructure required by a new development. ACT has backed reforms that give developers more options to fund the infrastructure their developments require, rather than simply loading those costs onto councils and existing ratepayers.

We also need a planning system that can actually deliver. ACT has driven the replacement of the RMA to make it easier and faster to build both housing and the infrastructure that supports it, rather than having one race ahead of the other.

At the same time, I don’t want growth to

come at the expense of what makes this part of Auckland such a great place to live. We have fantastic beaches, natural landscapes and a strong community identity. Maintaining good relationships with Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki, the Russell Property Group, Auckland Council and the wider community will be important as Beachlands South progresses.

What would you do to support better emergency and health service provision for Whitford, Beachlands and Maraetai?

Living further from central Auckland shouldn’t mean having poorer access to healthcare or emergency services. As Whitford, Beachlands and Maraetai continue to grow, we need to make sure local health services are keeping pace with that growth.

We’re fortunate to already have Beachlands Medical Centre and the Beachlands First Response Unit serving the community. As the population increases, particularly with developments like Beachlands South, those services will face greater demand. Planning for additional GP capacity, ambulance coverage and frontline services needs to happen now, rather than waiting until existing services are overwhelmed.

A growing community also needs the physical health infrastructure to match. That means making it easier to build new medical centres and allowing existing providers to expand as demand increases. ACT’s replacement of the RMA is an opportunity to remove unnecessary consenting barriers and fast-track essential community infrastructure.

We’ve also been focused on improving access to healthcare across the system. In Government, ACT secured the funding needed to address the \$1.774 billion shortfall in Pharmac’s medicines budget, helping give New Zealanders access to more medicines and treatments. We’re also pushing to make better use of pharmacists, allowing people to access more basic healthcare locally and taking some of the pressure off GPs and emergency departments.

As a local MP, I’d work with Health New Zealand, ambulance services and local healthcare providers to make sure planning and funding reflect where the population is actually growing. I’d also make sure organisations like Beachlands Medical Centre and the First Response Unit have a direct voice in those conversations.

What’s your view on what’s needed for roading, and how would you advocate for it?

Whitford Maraetai Road is already under significant pressure. Anyone who uses it regularly knows the issues around congestion, safety and maintenance, and with further development planned across the area, that pressure is only going to increase.

We need to be planning ahead. Rather than waiting until the road reaches breaking point, Auckland Council and central government need a clear understanding of what population growth will mean for traffic volumes and what upgrades will be required to keep people moving safely.

As a local MP, I’d be making the case for those upgrades based on the evidence: traffic volumes, safety risks, projected growth and the economic value of improving the route. Infrastructure investment should be prioritised according to where the need is greatest and where taxpayers and ratepayers will get the best value, rather than which project happens to have the strongest political backing.

That’s an approach ACT has been pushing in Government. Our Infrastructure spokesperson Simon Court has consistently argued for greater discipline around infrastructure spending and much better coordination between central government, councils and developers.

We can’t keep approving new housing and then asking existing residents to put up with worsening congestion, deteriorating roads and longer travel times. If we’re serious about accommodating growth in Beachlands, Maraetai and Whitford, the roads connecting these communities have to be part of the plan from the beginning.

How do you plan to make yourself visible and accessible to Pōhutukawa Coast residents?

I believe being a good local MP starts with actually being present in the community. You shouldn’t only hear from your MP when there’s an election coming up.

I’ll follow the example ACT has set in electorates like Epsom and Tāmaki, with David Seymour and James Christmas, by getting out from behind the desk and meeting people where they are. That means street corner meetings, Pints and Politics, coffee catch-ups, dropping into local businesses, attending community events, and simply being available for a conversation.

I also want to bring our wider ACT team into the area. Whether that’s the Deputy Prime Minister, our Ministers or other ACT MPs, I want to create opportunities for local businesses, community organisations and residents to speak directly with the people making decisions in Government.

The Pōhutukawa Coast is an important part of Botany, and I want residents to know they have someone who will show up, listen and take their concerns seriously.

I want to be an MP people regularly see around Beachlands, Maraetai and Whitford, not someone who appears every three years asking for their vote.

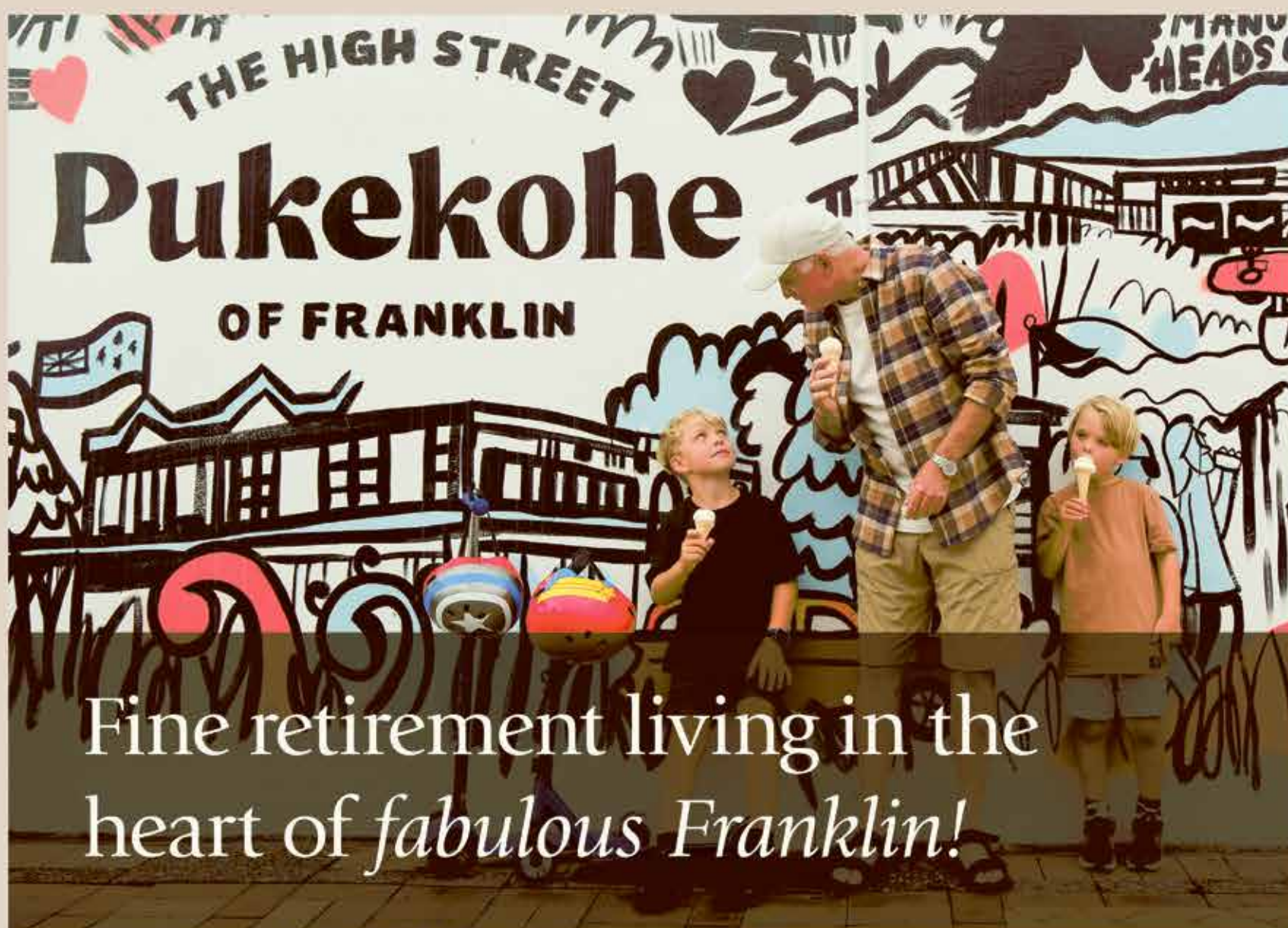

Love Tennis colouring competition!

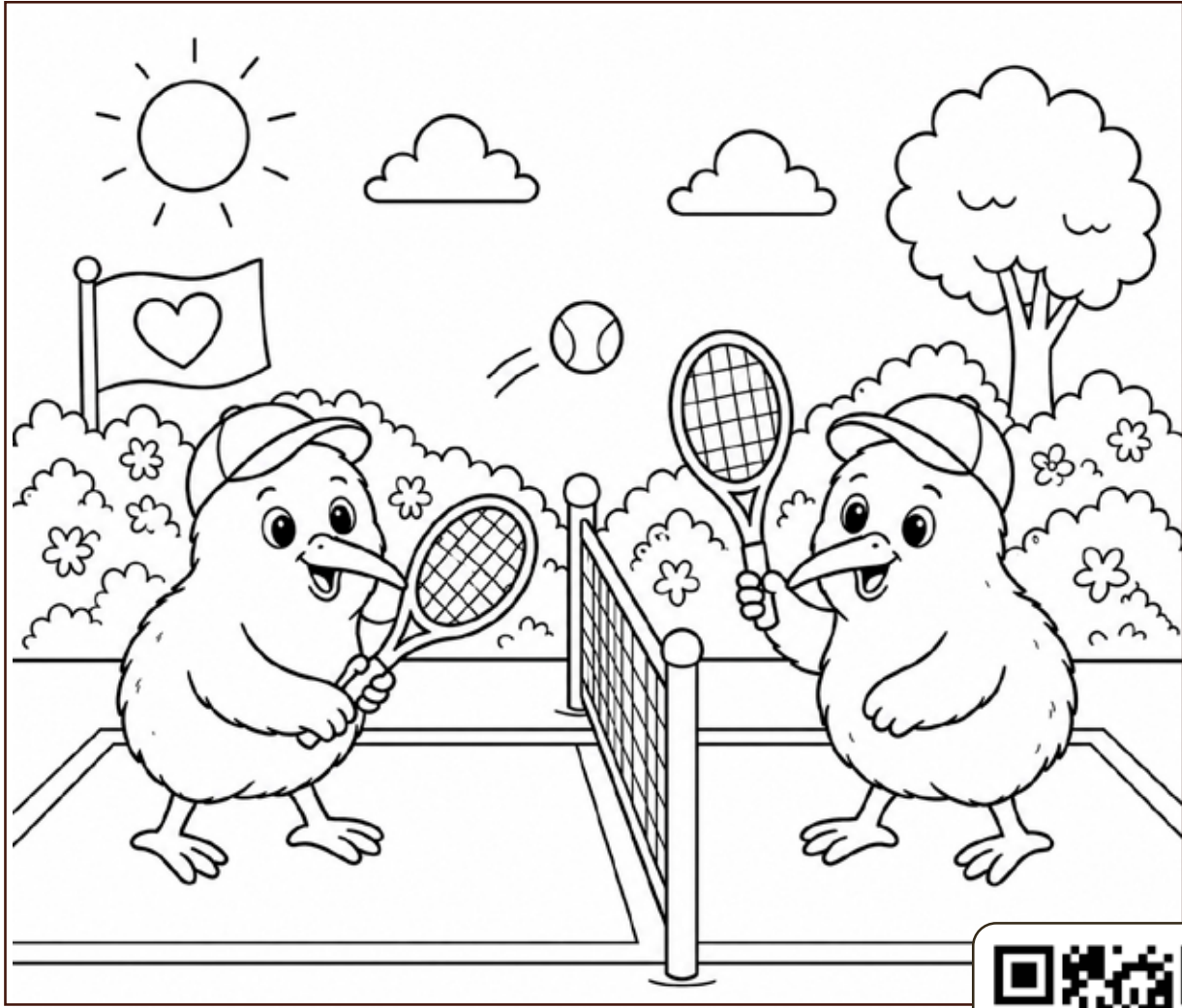
