Think you can 'patch and dispatch'? Join the Pōhutukawa Coast First Response Unit!

Almost every day somebody in Beachlands or Maraetai needs emergency medical care - and the small team who respond are calling on locals to join their ranks.

The Beachlands Hato Hone St John First Response Unit currently has ten members covering Beachlands and Maraetai, dispatched to approximately 400 medical incidents a year - an average of just over one call-out every day. All members are volunteers who fit their training and shifts around full-time jobs and family life.

"We're all volunteers, and we're all in the community," says team leader Pedro Silva. "Covering both day and night shifts across seven days requires a substantial commitment, so we need more people." The team's role is to reach patients as quickly as possible, assess their condition, provide immediate care and support them until a transporting ambulance crew arrives. Callouts cover a wide variety of scenarios, from CPR and defibrillation to pain relief for conditions like kidney stones, support during asthma attacks, or attending to motor vehicle crash injuries.

"We go there, we assess, we preserve life, and then we're

backed up by a crew that transports to hospital," says Pedro.

The team jokingly refer to their role as 'patch and dispatch'. Becoming a first responder involves around six months of training, split across four courses covering St John procedures, equipment handling, driving, and a two-weekend clinical course. Trainees then complete supervised real-world shifts before qualifying. All training is fully funded by Hato Hone St John.

People's reasons for joining the unit vary, but are generally underpinned by a desire to help their community.

For Mike, a manager at an engineering company, the motivation was partly professional curiosity, but mostly due to a frightening experience one Tuesday morning at 2am when one of his children woke up struggling to breathe.

"It was awful. We rang 111 and they said, yeah, that sounds really bad, we'll get an ambulance to you as soon as we can - it'll be about 45 minutes. And that was the most awful feeling, feeling so helpless... I didn't want to be in that situation again.

The year marches on, and Friends of Te Wairoa are pleased to be growing and evolving into different aspects of environmental restoration, continuing on our collective journey to enhance the mauri of the Wairoa River. We're able to build on our base workstreams thanks to ongoing support from various agencies, and this month we'd like to thank the Franklin Local Board for their ongoing support and confidence in us, confirming and increasing our funding for another year.

We're looking forward to our AGM on 8 September at the Hūnua Bowling Club. Presentations will be given by our contractors working on stream ecology, restoration and pest control in the catchment, sharing updates on the current health of the Wairoa River and our aspirations for the future. If you'd like to join us the doors are open from 6pm, with a cash bar available and nibbles provided. Anyone wanting to join the kaupapa on the committee can send nominations to info@tewairoa.org.nz before 2 September.

Independently of Friends of Te Wairoa, but with our support, a group has gathered to tackle pest plants in Clevedon. The Clevedon Pest Plant Group held their first working bees recently at the Clevedon Polo Club grounds to clear woolly nightshade and privet and will continue this mahi around the district every second Friday morning. Anyone interested to help can contact clevedonpestplantgroup@clevedon.co.nz. Many hands make light work, and together as a community we can restore healthy ecosystems.

Finally, Friends of Te Wairoa are excited to announce an upcoming Wetland Wānanga at the Hūnua Hall on 12 September. Wetlands are among Aotearoa's most valuable yet underappreciated natural treasures. Forming the vital transition between land and water, they are living ecosystems that constantly change with the seasons, rainfall and tides. Their beauty lies not only in their tranquil landscapes but also in the rich tapestry of native plants which thrive across the subtle shifts from freshwater to saltwater and from permanently wet to drier ground. Far more than scenic landscapes, wetlands are among the country's most productive habitats. They provide breeding grounds, shelter and food for many native species, while also improving water quality, reducing flooding and storing carbon, making them invaluable in the face of climate change. The wānanga will be led by Dr Rebecca Eivers of Wai Kōkopu Consulting whose mahi centres on the wai habitats that are inhabited and moved through by our Kōkopu species. Dr Eivers is a leading expert in constructed wetlands and wetland restoration, and she will be sharing her extensive scientific and practical knowledge with those eager to learn how wetlands can benefit both farming and nature. For generations wetlands were viewed as obstacles to progress. They were seen as land to be drained for farming or development, or places to discard rubbish. That attitude has come at a heavy cost, with much of Aotearoa's original wetlands disappearing. However, today there is growing recognition that wetlands are taonga—precious natural assets that deserve protection and restoration. Safeguarding these remarkable ecosystems is not simply about preserving wildlife; it is about ensuring future generations inherit a healthier, more resilient landscape that benefits both nature and our communities.

Friends of Te Wairoa are proud to be part of this change, connecting local landowners to the experts in the field and growing our collective understanding as kaitiaki of the landscapes around us, looking after it for the generations to come.

Hub now open for Coasters to use

The Beachlands Community Hub, located within the Beachlands Memorial Hall, is now open for the community to use, with the recent school holidays providing a varied programme of activities attended by about 240 children and family members. A dedicated community programme specialist has been appointed by Auckland Council, and is now onboard to help shape community hub programmes and activities. It's the first step towards a more fully-functioning hub, which will include relocation of the Beachlands Library into the hall later this year.

Auckland Council's Head of Community Delivery South, Kim Taunga, says the design and investigation phase of a programme of works for the Hub started earlier this year. Future planned works for the Hub include the conversion of an existing storeroom into a customer service space and the installation of technology, shelving and a new collection for the library.

"Before these works progress, the costs will be presented to the Franklin Local Board for approval in September. If approved, we expect the works to be completed by the end of the year," says Taunga.

Once complete, Taunga says the refreshed space will serve Beachlands' growing community by supporting reading and literacy, connection and creativity, featuring flexible areas to work, meet, create and recreate.

The facility was unable to be used as a hub by the public prior to July 1, as there were existing bookings in the space that Council needed to honour, with the venue now no longer available for hire.

"Afterwards I did some reading to figure out how it is we live in Auckland, yet minutes it can take a considerable amount of time potentially for an ambulance for a kid that is struggling to breathe. I found out there was one ambulance parked 800 metres from my house, but St John didn't have enough people to staff it. The next week I met Pedro in the supermarket carpark, and he said 'have you thought about volunteering?', so I signed up."

New recruit Chris works in the health and safety industry, and like Mike, has no medical background. He was drawn in after watching a friend volunteer with the fire service for decades. "He just seemed to be giving a lot back, and it was like, I need to be doing that."

Long-term volunteer Natalie's day job is health infrastructure project management. She says that after returning from a stint overseas where she looked after people with spinal injuries, she came home keen to give back to the community. "Then I came across a Hato Hone St John recruitment drive outside the post office here in Beachlands," she said. "I started talking to them and went, oh yeah, that sounds really awesome, I think I'd probably enjoy that... eleven and a half years later, I'm still here!"

Bernadine is one of the few volunteers

who came to the role with a clinical background - she works during the day as a GP practice nurse. She says she was inspired to join by her friend Michael, one of the unit's longest serving members. Bernadine's nursing training, and being a parent, helps her bring empathy to the role, and she says that the volunteer role has had the benefit of adding to her nursing skillset.

Natalie says the reward comes from being present for people during their worst moments. "Knowing that you have helped people at their worst - it could be the worst time of their life. Even if I can't fix it for them, just being there, and maybe providing reassurance and doing what we can... I always feel quite good about it afterwards."

All the team members agree that the life skills learned in the role have been empowering. Most have used their skills at unexpected moments - when people collapse at ANZAC Day services, when elderly neighbours have falls, or when family members need emergency medical care.

The team emphasise the camaraderie that comes with the role. "For me, it was actually finding my people," says Natalie. "It definitely attracts a certain type of person, people who remain calm under pressure and step forward when someone needs urgent care."

Volunteers are supported by a clinical desk. "We're never alone in a job," says Pedro. "We can always call the clinical desk for advice on certain medical situations."

Support is also provided in the tough times. The team debriefs after each shift, and Hato Hone St John provides a robust peer support programme.

"We get exposed to a lot of stuff," says Pedro. "Sometimes you need to vent. It might not affect you at the time, but you feel it later. Some things trigger some people and not others."

No medical background is required. What matters most, the volunteers say, is empathy and a willingness to give up time.

"I don't think there should be this perception that you need to be medical to do this," says Mike. "A lot of it is common sense. Prior qualification is not important, because every single one of us being so different brings something unique, and we lean on each other's skills."

With the population growing steadily and no immediate plans for a 24/7 crewed ambulance in the area, the team say more volunteers would ease the pressure on those currently covering the community.

"Locals should know how much is being held together by so little," says Mike. "If we can get a few more people who are motivated, it will make it so much more resilient for the future."

"Many hands make light work. The more people we can get on the team, the easier it is for everyone and the more sustainable we can be."

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Ancestral name restored to Ōmana Regional Park

Ōmana Regional Park has been given back its full ancestral name, Ō Manawatere, as part of a wider effort to strengthen the cultural identity of Tāmaki Makaurau and reconnect Auckland’s landscapes with their ancestral stories.

The restored name honours Manawatere, an ancient Ngāi Tai ki Tāmaki tupuna (ancestor) who journeyed from Hawaiki and explored much of eastern Tāmaki Makaurau. His travels, settlements, and descendants are woven throughout the region’s history. Over time, the original name was shortened to Ōmana. The restoration of Ō Manawatere, meaning “the place of Manawatere,” reconnects the landscape with its full ancestral story.

The change was formally adopted by Auckland Council’s Community Committee, allowing the te reo Māori name to sit alongside the existing English name, recognising and preserving both Māori and European histories.

Tumuaki Huanga Māori / Māori Outcomes Director Nicholas Turoa says the restored name reflects the rich identity of Tāmaki Makaurau and the histories that shape it.

“These names bring the stories of our places back into focus, strengthening the connection between whenua, whakapapa, and community,” he says. “This is about ensuring Aucklanders can see themselves in the places around them, and feel a

stronger connection to the stories, names and identities that make up Tāmaki Makaurau today.”

The renaming of Ōmana Regional Park is one of five regional park name restorations delivered through Te Kete Rukuruku, a partnership between Auckland Council, local boards, and mana whenua established to collect, protect, and share stories unique to ngā iwi o Tāmaki Makaurau. Since the programme began in 2017, 17 local boards have supported more than 580 local parks and public places across Auckland in receiving original and contemporary Māori names.

Further dual naming discussions are currently underway with mana whenua for additional parks across the region.

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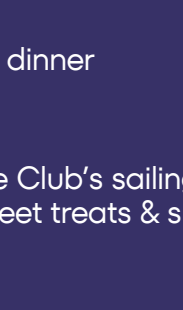
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Maraetai Library reopens following flood damage refurbishment

Maraetai Library will reopen its doors this weekend, following a refurbishment to repair water damage discovered early last year.

Council contractors identified damage to flooring, finishes, and internal fixtures during their assessment, leading to the library’s closure for about 18 months while the damage was repaired.

The works included a full renewal of the library’s flooring with new timber. The existing vinyl floor covering was replaced with premium grade vinyl, while the main library space received new Feltex carpet tiles.

New kitchen cabinetry was installed, and the hot water cylinder replaced. The kitchen and bathroom walls were repainted and accessibility improvements were also made, with two rubberised ramps installed at the main entrance. A new access door was also fitted.

The library is now back in action, and the community is welcome to come along and check it out this Saturday 15 August between 10am-12pm.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN HOWICK?

Community celebrates new landmark as puriri tree lights up Howick Village

A magnificent Puriri tree outside All Saints Anglican Church has become Howick Village’s newest illuminated landmark, following a small celebration on Tuesday 28 July at 6 pm, marking the power of community partnership.

The gathering brought together representatives from the Howick and Districts Freemasons Charitable Trust, All Saints Anglican Church, the Howick Local Board and the Howick Village Association to officially switch on more than 4,000 LED fairy lights adorning the historic tree.

Among those attending were Ray Burgess, Chair of the Howick and Districts Freemasons Charitable Trust, Vicar Ivica Gregurec and Sue from All Saints Anglican Church, Howick Local Board member Luke Collings, former HVA Chair Tony Moores, current Chair Sam Dalzell, Executive Committee member Paul Spiller, and HVA team members Katie Treneman, Jane Newbury and Marion Skelton.

The lighting project was made possible through the generous sponsorship of the Howick and Districts Freemasons Charitable Trust, with All Saints Anglican Church providing ongoing power for the lights.

A special acknowledgement was made to Mike Abercrombie, whose positivity and encouragement were instrumental in the project going ahead — without his support,

the tree would not have been lit.

Speaking at the celebration, Howick Village Association Village Manager Katie Treneman said the project was about far more than simply illuminating a tree.

“This tree represents far more than fairy lights. It represents what can happen when community organisations, charitable trusts, churches and passionate people come together with a shared vision to make Howick an even more beautiful place.”

Special recognition was also given to Jane Newbury, former Village Manager and current Events and Grants Manager at the HVA, whose determination and persistence through months of planning and grant applications brought the vision to life.

The project reflects one of the Howick Village Association’s key priorities. Recent surveys of local businesses identified streetscape improvements, particularly illuminated trees, as one of the Association’s highest priorities.

Standing beside historic All Saints Church and overlooking one of Howick’s oldest landmarks, the majestic Puriri tree now provides a welcoming beacon at the end of Picton Street. By day, visitors enjoy panoramic views across the Hauraki Gulf towards Beachlands and Waiheke Island; by night, the softly illuminated tree creates a warm and welcoming and magical atmosphere for residents and visitors alike.

The installation comprises 300 metres of fairy lights, made up of 100 individual three-metre light strings containing a total of 4,000 LED lights. While sponsorship funded the installation, the Howick Village Association will continue to invest in the ongoing maintenance of the illuminated tree as part of its commitment to enhancing the village streetscape.

Following the official lighting, Vicar Ivica

Gregurec offered a few words before guests stayed to celebrate the occasion together.

The new illuminated Puriri joins the growing collection of fairy-lit trees throughout Howick Village, continuing the Association’s vision of creating a vibrant, welcoming and memorable destination for the community and visitors throughout the year.
